WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST



AEDÍN MOLONEY (Molly Bloom, Co-Adaptor)) is an award-winning actress, also founder and producing artistic director of Fallen Angel Theatre Company. In 2017 she released an

unabridged audio recording of Molly Bloom's Soliloguy from *Ulysses* by James Joyce, Reflections of Molly Bloom, with music by her father, Paddy Moloney. Following the success of Yes! Reflections of Molly Bloom premier in 2019, (her 10th production at Irish Rep and her first adaptation), Aedín was honored by The Outer Critics Circle and nominated by The Off-Broadway Alliance for performance. Previous roles at Irish Rep include: The Dead, 1904, Dancing at Lughnasa, The Playboy of the Western World. The Shadow of a Gunman and Airswimming (a co-production with Fallen Angel). She originated the role of George Eliot in the acclaimed production of A Most Dangerous Woman at STNJ. Other recent roles include Women Without Men (The Mint), The Alchemist (STNJ) and When I was a Girl I used to Scream and Shout (Fallen Angel). Her most recent TV credits include: "The Exorcist" and "The Knick." She played the role of Eva Joyce in the film "Nora" (based on the life of Nora Barnacle). She recently directed Melissa Gilbert in My Brilliant Divorce with Fallen Angel. Aedín was born and raised in Dublin, Ireland. Yes! Reflections of Molly Bloom is Aedín's first theatrical video, shot on an iPhone while under Covid lockdown from a bedroom in Miami. It is a testament to surviving the loneliness of self isolation.

JAMES JOYCE (Writer 1882-1941) Best known for Ulysses, a landmark work in which the episodes of Homer's Odyssey are paralleled in an array of contrasting literary styles, James Joyce also wrote the short-story collection Dubliners and the novels A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man (1916) and Finnegans Wake (1939). He was once quoted as saying "For myself, I always write about Dublin, because if I can get to the heart of Dublin I can get to the heart of all the cities of the world. In the particular is contained the universal"

(Co-Adaptor) Colum COLUM McCANN McCann is the author of 7 novels and 3 collections of stories. Born and raised in Dublin. Ireland, he has been the recipient of many international honours, including the National Book Award, the International Dublin Impac Prize, a Chevalier des Arts et Lettres from the French government, election to the Irish arts academy, several European awards, the 2010 Best Foreign Novel Award in China, and an Oscar nomination. In 2017 he was elected to the American Academy of Arts. His work has been published in over 40 languages. He is the co-founder of the nonprofit global story exchange organisation, Narrative 4, and he teaches at the MFA program in Hunter College. He lives in New York with his wife. Allison, and their three children. colummccann.com

WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST

PADDY MOLONEY (Music) is the founder and leader of six-time Grammy award winners. The Chieftains. He is known over the world, not only for his innovative, ground breaking work in traditional Irish music but as a pioneering force behind the exploration of Celtic culture and its history. Molonev has been an Irish cultural ambassador for over 50 years. Through his research and recordings, exploring Irish roots in Breton, Galician, Country, Bluegrass, Cuban and Mexican music, he has created a vast body of work. Known for his collaborative nature, his albums with The Chiefains include guest performances by Paul McCartney, Art Garfunkel, Sting, The Rolling Stones, Elvis Costello, Diana Krall, Van Morrison, James Galway, Joni Mitchell, and Liam Neeson to name but a few. He has composed, produced and performed on numerous film scores including Gangs of New York, Barry Lyndon, Agnes Browne, Tristan and Isolde, Treasure Island, The Water Horse, Far and Away, The Grev Fox, the PBS/Disney mini-series The Long Journey Home. The Ballad of the Irish Horse (for National Geographic) and many more, 42 albums (5 of them #1 on Billboard World Music), 6 Grammys, 18 nominations, an Oscar, a Genie and an Emmy later, we can only begin to touch the surface of his achievements. He is delighted to have a chance once again to collaborate with his beloved daughter, Aedín.

M. FLORIAN STAAB (Sound Design, Mlx, Music Recording and Editor) is a sound designer and composer based in Brooklyn,

Ciarán has been inducted in to the Irish America Hall of Fame and was awarded the Presidential Distinguished Service Award for the Irish Abroad, 2019 by President Michael D. Higgins.
