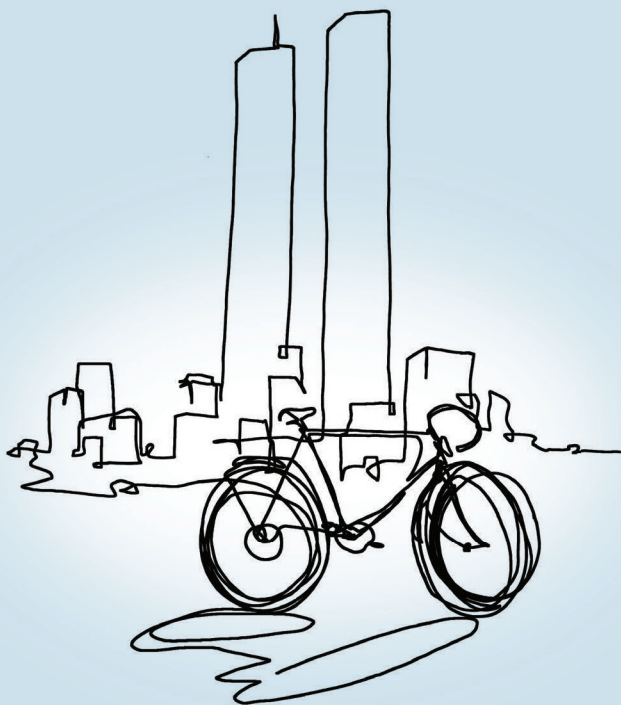

TOM FLYNN (*Poet, Author, Photographer*)

Tom Flynn, the author of *Bikeman*, is an award-winning broadcast journalist. For more than a quarter century, he worked as a writer and producer for CBS News. He was Dan Rather's writer/producer at "48 HOURS," a broadcast he helped create; an investigative producer at the "CBS Evening News," and he was a producer for Steve Kroft at "60 Minutes." He's been honored by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences with 15 Emmy Award nominations, winning 6. He was also honored with the prestigious Peabody Award for his work on "48 HOURS." The publishers of *Bikeman*, Andrews/McMeel, just released a Commemorative Edition in to mark the 20th anniversary of 9/11. Flynn is married to Nancy Reardon with whom he co-wrote *On Camera*. They split their time between New York City and Cape Cod. Their daughter Kate and her husband Marc Mewshaw live in Brooklyn.

JOSEPH DISCHER (*Director*) most recently adapted and directed two

immersive audio experiences with Knock at the Gate; William Shakespeare's *Caesar*, and *Macbeth: A Surround Sound Experiment*, which was featured on *Good Day New York*, *American Theatre* magazine, and raised ten thousand dollars for The Actors Fund last year. A Letter from the Directors

It has often been said that people can remember precisely what they were doing when the planes pounded the Twin Towers on that “forever September morning” in 2001.

To add to that decree, we can remember precisely what we were doing when we read Tom Flynn’s epic poem *Bikeman*. The great actor, Robert Cuccioli, had delivered the script and we were sitting at our desks where we remained breathless to the end.

In tone and substance, Tom’s journey into hell recalled Beowulf, bearing witness to a timeless story with the detailed mind of a first-class journalist and the heart of a mighty poet.

On that day, twenty years ago, as we wandered helplessly around the streets of Chelsea smelling the acrid smoke and watching the clouds of ash falling from the sky, we could only imagine the suffering and loss twenty blocks below.

Now, twenty years later, his words bring back the full horror and anguish of that morning. Many of the sounds heard on this audio came from a videographer from Merrill Lynch whom the Author had hired that morning impromptu. Here is a first-hand account of a living history that changed the landscape of the world and made orphans of the families of the deceased.

We are thinking of the families on this 20th Anniversary and our pledge is to share 50% of all donations we receive from this airing with the [Families of Freedom Scholarship Fund](#) - an organization formed to provide education assistance for postsecondary study to financially needy dependents of those people killed or permanently disabled as a result of the terrorist attacks and during the rescue activities relating to those attacks.

We would normally sign off by saying “enjoy” but perhaps it is more appropriate to say: “Experience. Honor. Remember.”
