A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

It's hard to believe Synge lived only 37 years. What a legacy he left us in such a short time. I selected two of his very early works (both preceded his much-lauded *The Playboy of the Western World*) because I think they are small masterpieces - he captures the experience of the rural, Irish poor in such a vivid, human way.

Synge wrote of his own works:

"I am sending you a play which I wrote some years ago but did not publish till the other day - *The Tinker's Wedding* - as you will understand we think it too dangerous to put on in the Abbey. It is founded on an incident which happened in Wicklow a few years ago."

- In a Letter to friend James Paterson, March 27, 1908

"When I was writing *The Shadow Of The Glen* some years ago, I got more than any learning could have given me, from a chink in the floor of the old Wicklow house where I was staying, that let me hear what was being said by the servant girls in the kitchen...In Ireland, for a few years more, we have a popular imagination that is fiery and magnificent and tender."

- Preface for The Playboy of the Western World, January 21, 1907

SYNGE MILLINGTON (Playwright) (1871–1909) Edmund John Millington "J.M." Synge was an Irish playwright, poet, prose writer, writer, and collector travel folklore. He was a key figure in the Irish Literary Revival and was one of the cofounders of the Abbev Theatre. W.B. Yeats encouraged him to live for a time in the Aran Islands to aquaint himself with the Irish people and to gain an understanding of the Irish language. His best known play, The Playboy of the Western World, was inspired by his time there, and caused riots in Dublin during its opening run at the Abbey Theatre. All of his dramatic works were written in the seven years between 1902 and his death, at the age of 37 in 1909.

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






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
