Physical Requirements & Weather

Dublin is a city best experienced on foot. We suggest that all guests be able to walk approximately 2-4 miles unassisted each day, though travelers are welcome to travel by taxi or public transit on their own between destinations. Elevators will usually be available as an alternative to stairs, though there will be at least two locations we visit where climbing 1-2

flights of stairs will be required. Unfortunately, this trip is not appropriate for travelers using wheelchairs or other mobility aids.

October weather in Dublin generally includes mist, showers, and temperatures ranging in the 40s and 50s. Dublin has a fair amount of uneven, hilly sidewalks and cobblestones.

Proof of Citizenship

U.S. Citizens are required to have a valid passport while traveling abroad. Travel to Ireland requires that the expiration date of your passport not occur within six months of the termination date of your trip. We can not offer guidance for non U.S. citizens; contact your travel professional for additional information.

Travel Insurance

While not required, Irish Repertory Theatre strongly recommends travel insurance to protect you from cancellation penalties.

Payment
